Preparing for Your Tournaments: Documentation and Reporting

BEFORE THE TOURNAMENTS

Your tournament applications have been submitted

You have received the technical rules and templates, to prepare for the tournaments

Next steps:

- Review and approve the technical rules (<u>Detailed instructions</u>)
- Access the member's folder and begin using it (<u>Detailed instructions</u>)
- Complete application forms for your teams and referees and upload them to the appropriate folders no later than two weeks before the tournament start date



BEFORE THE TOURNAMENTS

After uploading all the information to the WPC member folder, ensure you are prepared to:

- Carefully review the regulatory documentation in the WPC member folder once again (rulebook, regulations on the ranking system, match report templates, tournament grid, and tournament reports)
- Co-ordinate all tasks with your operations team
- Inspect the venue setup ensuring all equipment is available and functional
- Ensure the participation of all confirmed teams
- Arrange the schedules of all confirmed referees



DURING YOUR TOURNAMENTS

Complete the following documents after each match, as per protocol:

- Fill out the match report after each match
- Update the tournament grid after each match

Match reporting document - Auto-updates once results are entered

<u>Detailed instructions</u> - Detailed breakdown of all required reports



DURING YOUR TOURNAMENTS

Prepare a technical photo report:

- General photos of the venue
- Photos of the field/arena, including both digital and physical parts
- Photos of competition equipment
- Photos of spectator seating
- Photos of branding
- Photos of installed broadcast equipment
- Photos of all teams before each game, similar to the example on the right ->





Prepare a video report for each game, i.e. videos of the first 10 seconds of each game, similar to the example on the right

<u>Detailed instructions</u> - Detailed breakdown of all required reports





POST YOUR TOURNAMENTS

- Upload all collected information including your photo and video reports to your folder within three business days following the completion of your tournaments
- The WPC will review the uploaded materials and provide feedback if necessary
- If there are no comments, the WPC will issue a certificate confirming the tournament's evaluation and rating
- By February 10, 2025, the summary ranking of teams will be published on WPC resources, determining eligibility for the GOTF and the GOTF qualifiers



POST YOUR TOURNAMENTS

We require a full social and PR report of your tournaments.

Please provide us with:

- Key information about your event including all participating teams and who they represent if necessary (for instance, a team might be from a university, a company, town/city, etc.)
- Key details that you would like to highlight such as the results of the tournament, all relevant imagery and video content
- If the tournament was broadcast live, please provide the total number of views
- Kindly prepare this in a docx or pdf format.
- In addition, please outline any media that covered the event by filling in this <u>template</u>
